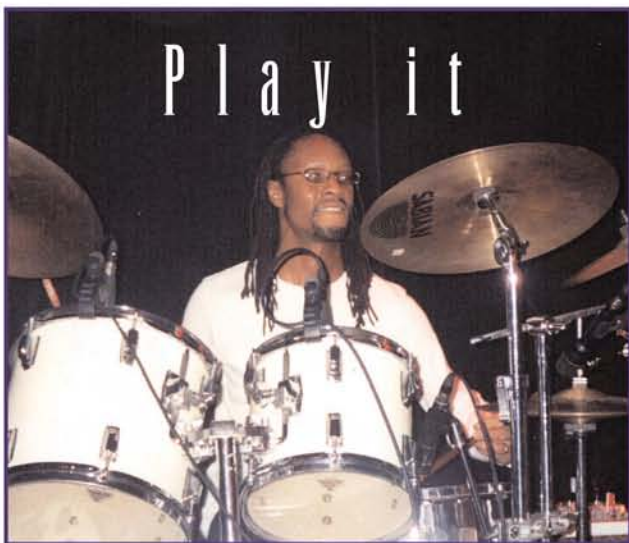

A presentation workshop for the young musicians of tomorrow

Objective:

To provide young music students as well as non-music students with an interactive introductory experience into the world of rhythm and percussion.

Moments in Rhythm

The presentation:

A fun interactive performance showcasing rhythm from the drumset. The students get to see a performing musician up close as I discuss rhythm and how it relates to popular music of today with many fun examples. The presentation helps to enrich the students appreciation for music, drumming and rhythm, while motivating them to do their best at whatever they choose to do.



- **Small Workshops**

All students can benefit from Moments in Rhythm. The workshop is structured in such a way that it assumes the student has little or no experience reading music. Basic reading can be reviewed and reinforced with examples throughout. I explore rhythm, reading and writing music, using various hand percussion. I also cover Practical application as well as small ensemble playing.

Duration is approx. 60 min.

- **Clinics/Tutorial**

For more advanced drummers. Cover specific techniques, rudiments, reading for the snare as well as drumset applications. Covers various styles of playing including: Bigband, Jazz, Latin, Funk and Pop-rock. Duration is approx. 60 min.

- **Bucket Drumming**

Becoming a very popular and inexpensive opportunity for students of all ages to develop or enhance their rhythm reading skills. The bucket bands are made up of 10 to 35 students usually from grades 3 and up. All students are taught to read rhythm using David's own unique method. This method has students ready to perform their rhythm pieces after approximately 4–6 weekly sessions. The bucket bands are very impressive and always leave the students cheering with satisfaction and excitement once they have learned their music!



David Lowe is a professional drummer who has performed in professional stage and theatre productions including Pirates of Penzance, Fiddler on the Roof, and Guys and Dolls. As founder and leader of his own funk jazz band Achanti, he was the driving force behind the band, and wrote most of the band's music and lyrics. David currently works as a freelance drummer throughout the Toronto area and can often be seen performing in hotels, private functions, and night clubs.

Drawing on over 20 years of teaching experience, he not only teaches privately but also conducts many rhythm/percussion workshops and tutorials in schools throughout Peel and surrounding areas. It is his love and passion for music and drumming that lead him to develop his popular Moments in Rhythm Program.
